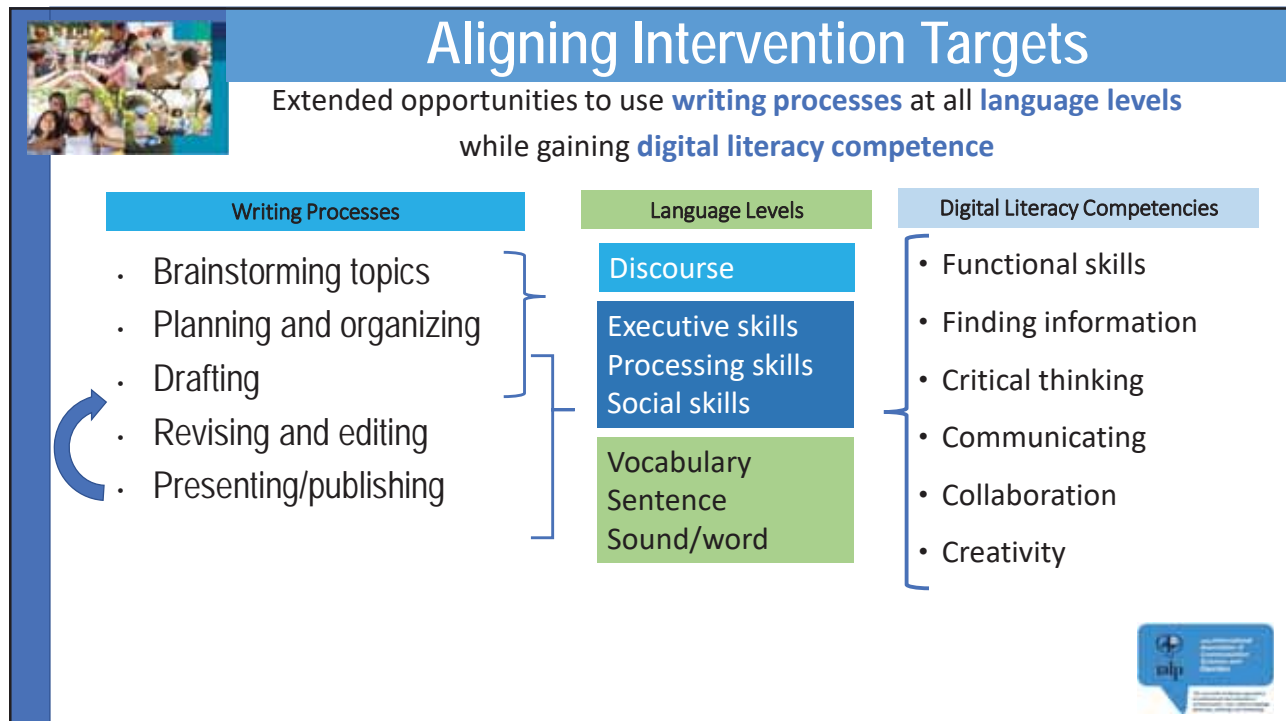
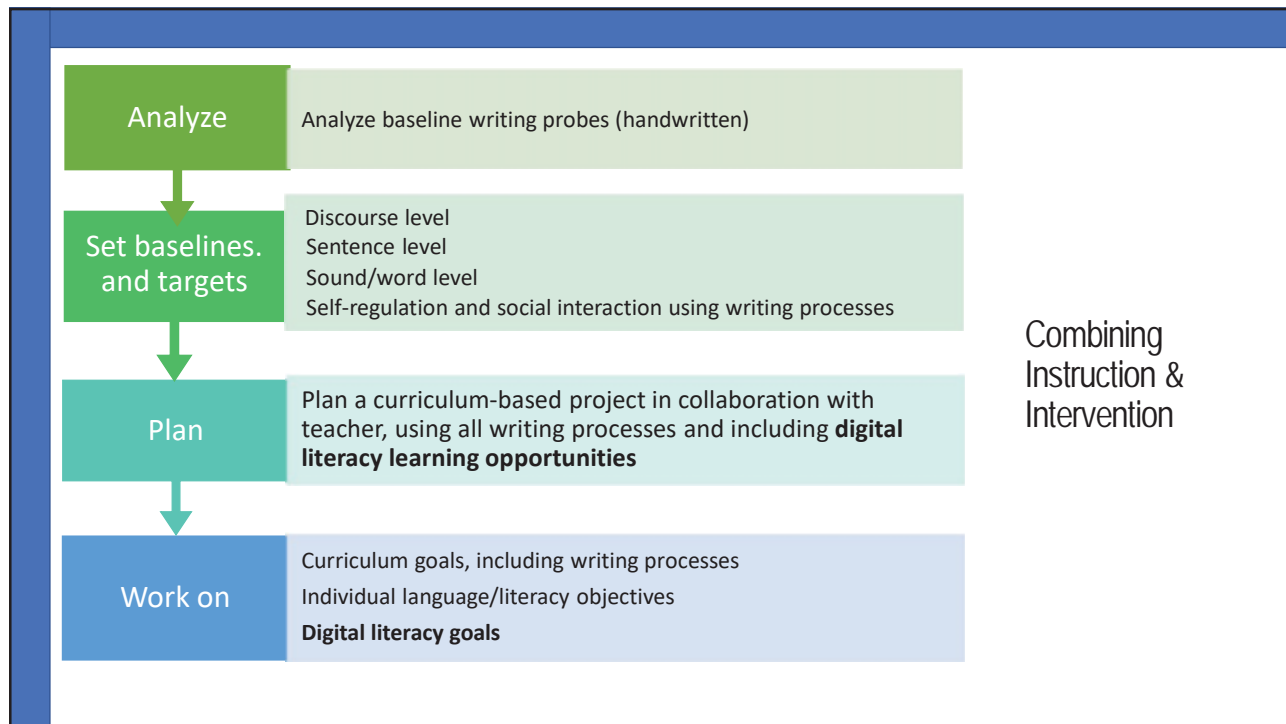
## The Writing Lab Approach to Language Instruction and Intervention

## Digital Literacy Functional Skills can be targeted in *all stages of the writing process*

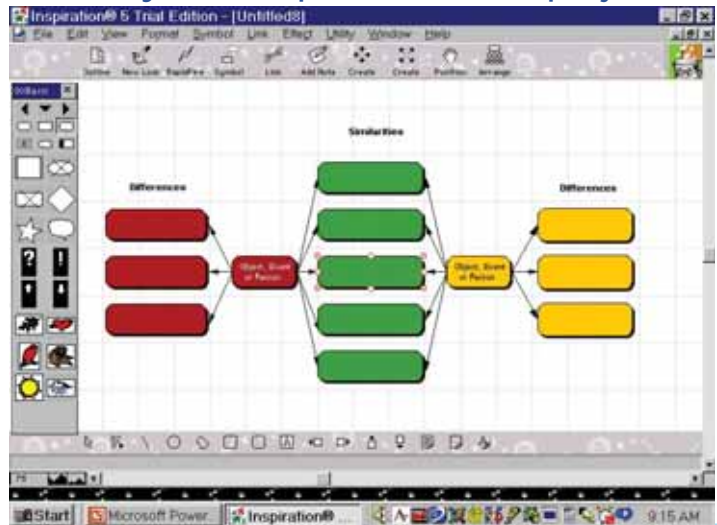
- Planning supports

  - Fonts, borders, illustrations
  - Presentation software
  - Writing with a partner in shared docs





## Targeting digital literacy in Compare/Contrast projects

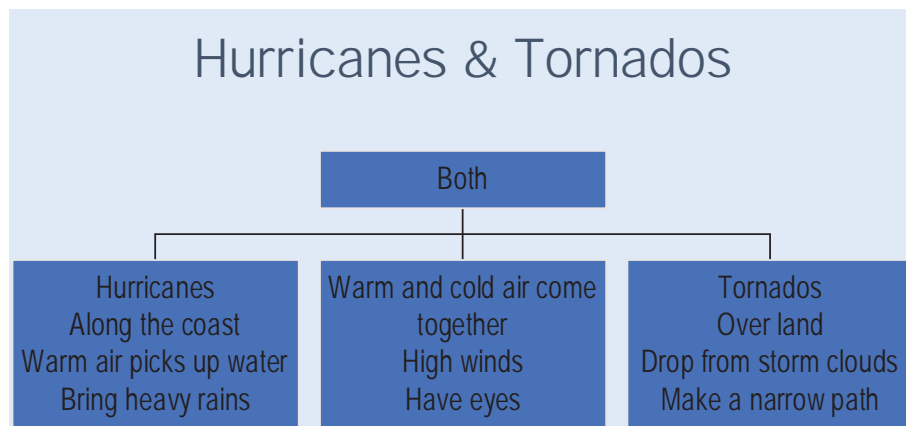
- Grade 3



## Curriculum Activity for Grade 3 student with DLD: *Animal Essay*

### Classroom lessons for Jacob (age 8)

- Vocabulary
  - Animal choice
  - Digital literacy concepts – entering key words
- Graphic organizer – use questions to help find key words
- Find information – read to see if it answers questions
  - What does that mean?
  - What does the author want us to know?
- Take notes:
  - Read it
  - Cover it or darken the screen
  - Say it in your own words
- Organize notes (critical thinking)
  - What goes with that?
  - Is there anything else we should tell the reader?
- Author chair
  - Read draft
  - Call on peers to comment and question
  - Use input to add information
